



Applying for your Competition Licence

Eligibility

Members of CASC Ontario affiliated clubs are eligible to apply for regional competition licences through CASC Ontario Region, and for national and international competition licences through ASN Canada FIA.

Required Documentation

Please include proof of membership with an affiliated club with your competition licence application. Renewing members and non-members can also join a club of their choice when applying for a competition licence. A listing of CASC Ontario affiliated clubs is below, and is updated regularly on the organization's website, at www.casc.on.ca. A currently valid medical report is also required.

Medical Report

Members aged 16 to 34 must have the CASC Ontario Region medical form completed by a physician every five years. The report is required every two years for members aged 35-59, and annually for members 60+.

Two Ways To Apply

Online: Club memberships and competition licences are now available for online application and renewal. Log into the 'Members Only' area at www.casc.on.ca, using your e-mail address and password. You can also renew your membership with any of our affiliated clubs with secure online credit card payment.

By Mail: Fill out and mail the Competition Licence Application form, with all other required documentation, to the CASC Ontario region office. Please include a cheque, payable to 'CASC Ontario Region'. Our mailing address:

Regional Licence Grades

Regional A (Full Regional Race Licence)

- o Valid for all CASC Ontario-sanctioned motorsport events in Ontario
- o Equivalent with SCCA Regional licences in the USA
- o Applications require:
 - Currently valid membership with a CASC Ontario affiliated club
 - Completed CASC Ontario licence application online or by mail
 - Currently valid CASC Ontario or ASN Canada FIA medical form
 - Licence fee of \$125.⁰⁰ (including GST).

Regional B (Novice Regional Race Licence)

- o Valid for all CASC Ontario-sanctioned motorsport as above
- o 'Novice' grade licence requiring special provisions as outlined in Appendix G of the RaceOntario Regulations.
- o Applications require:
 - Currently valid membership with a CASC Ontario affiliated club
 - Completed CASC Ontario licence application online or by mail
 - Graduation certificate from a CASC Ontario or ASN Canada FIA-accredited race school, or approval from the CASC Ontario Race Director
 - Currently valid CASC Ontario or ASN Canada FIA medical form
 - Licence fee of \$125.⁰⁰ (including GST), or \$75.⁰⁰ (incl. GST) if upgrading from a Regional C licence.

Regional C (Basic Competition Licence)

- o Required for Ice Racing and Solo 1 Time Trials. (Licences are not required for Solo II Autoslalom events).
- o Applications require:
 - Currently valid membership with a CASC Ontario affiliated club
 - Completed CASC Ontario licence application online or by mail
 - Licence fee of \$50.⁰⁰ including GST.
