



ONTARIO TIME ATTACK CURB WEIGHT OPTION SUBMISSION

PLEASE READ SECTION 5.1D FROM THE CASC-OR 2013 ONTARIO TIME ATTACK REGULATIONS (SEE BELOW) TO DETERMINE WHETHER YOUR VEHICLE REQUIRES OR IS ELIGIBLE TO SUBMIT THIS FORM. IT IS THE COMPETITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES.

5.1D CURB WEIGHT OPTION

Any competitor whose vehicle is equipped with: a roll cage meeting Ontario Time Attack regulations (as defined in Section 1.3 and 1.4), a roll bar in a hard topped car meeting Ontario Time Attack regulations and/or an Ontario Time Attack legal engine swap (as defined in Section 5.0G) may opt to provide the Car Classification Committee with 'race trim' curb weight data to be substituted into the spreadsheet for classification purposes. This option replaces Section 5.1C, meaning that no PIPs need to be declared in the 'Body & Trim' section of the rulebook.

In order for the CCC to accept the accuracy and validity of the curb weight data provided by a competitor, the vehicle MUST be weighed in full 'race trim' defined as: full fluids (i.e. brake, transmission, coolant, and fuel); competition wheels and tires; no spare tire, jack, floor mats and any other items normally removed prior to Ontario Time Attack competition; any/all other Body & Trim modifications as the car will sit in pit lane during Ontario Time Attack competition. The weighing must be conducted on properly calibrated and operated corner weight scales capable of accurately measuring passenger vehicle weight.

Note: Ballast or the addition of any fixed dead weight for the purposes of increasing 'race trim' weight and thus lower a vehicle's classification is prohibited. Exceptions may be made, at the discretion of the Classification Committee or Ontario Time Attack Director, that allow regional race cars (i.e. Touring GT Championship) equipped with ballast to compete without being required to remove the ballast.

All cars with more than 4 unfactored body pips MUST submit a race curb weight
