

### CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News, **Event # 5 Director's Report**



The second event in the second double header Autoslalom weekend of the season had the Ontario regional competitors back at Bronte GO Station in Oakville for Event # 5 of the CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News. Event #5 was hosted by HADA Motorsport Club and was organized by the reigning Overall Series Champion, Hanif Premji on June 18<sup>th</sup> 2006. 68 competitors were in attendance at one of the best Autoslalom lots in the Greater Toronto Area.



The weather once again was almost perfect although it was a little on the hot and humid side, nothing out of the ordinary for summers in Southern Ontario. It was extremely windy later in the day though, windy enough that the organizing club had to create two more marshalling positions, Tent Peg 1 and Tent Peg 2, to assist in holding down the timing tent.

This was another event that had some great class battles taking place throughout the day. D Super Stock had Brian L in his Acura Integra Type R nudging Daniel F in his Subaru Impreza 2.5 RS by

15/100ths of a second for the class win. These two have been involved in some great battles all year this year.

In E Street Prepared, Tashko S turned the tables on Paul M from the previous day taking his TDS Engineering / Cooksville Mitsubishi / SensoryOverload.ca Mitsubishi Eclipse GSX to the class win over Paul's Subaru Impreza WRX, by 2/10ths of a second.















E Super Stock had Rhys H and his Subaru WRX edging out fellow SPDA member Peter W and his Subaru WRX Wagon by 7/10ths of a second with Doug P another 1/10<sup>th</sup> back of Peter in his Chevrolet Camaro Z28.

In C Stock four Mazda Miatas battled it out and long time competitor Stephen T took the class win from Eric R by a half second with Curtis S another tenth of a second behind Eric.

Things were most interesting in D Stock where a couple of the best Autoslalom drivers in the province were really duking it out. In addition to the Ontarians, HADA Motorsport Club has a club sponsor in TRAC Racing Depot, based out of St-Eustache Quebec, and one of the key TRAC people is Carl Wener. Carl, an avid Solo 2 competitor and a regular at various Solo and Race events across North



America, made the trip from Montreal just to participate in this Ontario Regional Event. To make things interesting, Carl had the reigning Overall Series Champion, Hanif P, co-driving his TRAC Racing Acura Integra Type R for the day. The two Type R drivers were pitted against the MaszdaSpeed Proteges of Brain S, a former Series Rookie of the Year, and Bill R from Lansdowne Ontario, east of Kingston and the 2004 Series Overall Champion, David S, co-driving his brother, Brian's MOSI Race Dynamics / eterness.com / Dave Wood Mazda Protégé.



Hanif managed to beat Carl in Carl's own vehicle by almost 4/10ths of a second, a substantial upset. Bill R finished 15/100ths behind Carl and Brian S another 2/10ths behind Bill. David S finished in fifth place, 6/10ths back of his brother Brian. A very interesting battle indeed.... The day ended a little early for Carl as on Hanif's last run they broke a drive shaft in the Type R. As usual, the HADA crew, specifically Andrew D, aka Moose, were all over it. Shortly after the clean up at the end of the event the drive shaft had been replaced and Carl was ready for the five hour trip back home to Montreal.

G Stock once again had some close battles. Ryan M, in a borrowed Mazda Protégé MP3 manage a class win over Trung D and his Subaru Impreza RS by  $3/10^{th}$  of a second, with the 2005 G Stock Champion Cliff S in his Plymouth Neon another 3/10ths back and Mike M in his MOSI Race Dynamics Mazda Protege MP3 in fourth a further 7/100ths of a second behind Cliff.

When the results were calculated at the end of the day and the PAX applied to all the competitors best run times, Hanif P was on top of the heap. In Ontario, to encourage competitors to step up and organize events on the Regional schedule, the organizer of any event is not scored for that specific event, based on their results from the day. Instead they are given the equivalent to their best score of any other event over the course of the season. This meant that Hanif would receive 100 points for the Overall Championship; based on one of two events he had already scored 100 points for and the results had to be recalculated. After the recalculation, Carl W took the



"Northern Motorsport Top Scorer Award" for Event #5 with the perfect score of 100 followed by Mike A in his D Street Prepared Subaru Impreza 2.5 RS with a score of 99.735 and D Stock's Bill R and his Mazdaspeed Protégé in third with a score of 99.643. In fact the top 6 competitors all scored above 99 points towards the Overall Championship and the top 9 scored above 98 points. The course didn't seem to favour any particular class at this event.

Once again the Top Novice for Event # 5 was Gary W in his B Stock Mazda RX-8, followed by Douglas M in his D Stock Subaru Legacy 2.5GT and Jonas L in his D Street Prepared Volkswagen Scirocco in third.

Four competitors broke the 40 second barrier on the course with the Fastest Time of the Day going to Paul K in his supercharged Mazda Miata from C Street Prepared with a time of 39.132 seconds followed by D Street Prepared's Mike A and his Subaru Impreza 2.5 RS with a time of 39.470 and third place in the Fastest Times of the Day went to Andrew C in his C Modified Volkswagen Scirocco with a time of 39.517 seconds.

















With half the events in the CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News already taken place, the reigning Overall Champion Hanif P has the Overall Championship lead followed by H Stock's Pete M in second, E Super Stock's Rhys H in second, F Street Prepared's Joe T is fourth and G Stock's Trung D is in fifth. Hanif is still a couple of events away from wrapping up the championship once again, but he is well on his way to retaining the title.....

The next event in the CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News will take place on July 9<sup>th</sup>, at Douro Arena outside of Peterborough and will be hosted by Peterborough MotorSport Club (PMSC).
