CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series

Event # 10 Director's Report



The final event in the CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News season was held at Mosport's Driver Development Track (DDT) north of Bowmanville and was hosted by Oshawa Motor Sport Club (OMSC). Event organizer Jeff Christie made use of the DDT's old Powell Track configuration with strategically placed cones on the circuit to keep things safe and everyone on the tarmac. Actually, anyone who even touched the dirt or grass with a tire was DNF'd (scored as Did Not Finish), just to ensure the safety aspect of the event. OMSC had a quick 50 plus second plus course that had almost all the desirable features you would want in an Autoslalom course.

The weather on the morning of September 17th was cool and foggy upon arriving at the DDT. It remained slightly cloud covered most of the day with short bursts of sunlight making it through the clouds later in the day. Temperatures were reasonable and actually quite comfortable.

As with some previous events, there weren't a lot of close class battles to be had. C Stock was by far the closest with Eric R. in his 01 Mazda Miata with a time of 53.736 seconds just edging out Rob H. in his 05 Mazda Miata MX-5 with a time of 53.786 seconds.



This class was won by a mere 5/100ths of a second.

The next closest class battle was in E Super Stock where Doug P. in his Camaro Z28 just nudged Ottawa's Steven P. in his Subaru WRX wagon. Doug set a time of 50.650 seconds on his last run of the day just beating

Steven's time of 50.781 seconds. Both had realized before their last runs that both Overall points win and the Fastest Time of the Day were within reach and pushed hard on their last runs. Doug managed to improve and Steven pushed too hard and unfortunately wasn't able to improve.

F Stock had brothers Ben and Allen W. battling it out in a Pontiac Trans Am with Ben coming out on top with a time of 53.084 seconds compared to Allen's time of 53.523 seconds. Also, Class C Modified had Guillermo A. just beating out Opal G. in the same shared Honda Civic. Guillermo set a time of 52.729 seconds while the Silvermouse.ca sponsored Opal had a fastest time of 53.349 seconds.

Like the penultimate event that had taken place the weekend before in Kanata, the battle really heated up after the PAX (a performance index system used to level the playing field for all competitors) was applied to the competitor times for of the Overall Championship points. For Event #10, the top five scorers for Overall all scored above 99 points.



The Event #10 "Northern Motorsport Top Scorer Award", taking his second Overall event win in the last three events, was H Stock's Wes T. in his Reaction Grafix / Tsunami Technologies / Wheel & Tire Zone / Pathfinder Lubricants / CG-Lock Honda Civic SiR, scoring the 100 points towards the Overall Championship. The 100 points in Event #10 assured Wes of his fourth place finish in the Overall Championship. Second place Overall for the event was the now two time Series Overall Champion Hanif P. with a score of 99.853, followed in third by D Street Prepared's Mike A. in his Subaru Impreza 2.5 RS with a score of 99.668, moving Mike up to fifth in the Overall Championship. Fourth and fifth for the event were the above mentioned Doug P. and Steven P. with score of 99.309 and 99.053 respectively.

The Top Novice for Event #10 was once again Gary W in his B Stock Mazda RX-8 who basically cruised to the Series Novice Championship but was kept honest by Douglas M and his Subaru Legacy 2.5GT who finished second in the Novice Championship both at this event and for the Series Novice Championship.

The Fastest Time of the Day once again went to Mike A. in his Subaru Impreza 2.5 RS with a time of 49.325 seconds followed by fellow SPDA member Stephen D. in his B Street Prepared Four Star Motorsports / Wheel and Tire Zone / Hot Bits Performance Parts Subaru Sti with a time of 50.124 seconds. The third fastest time was set by Doug P. with a time of 50.650 seconds, fourth was Trung D. in his D Street Prepared Dodge Neon with a time of 50.727 and fifth was set by Steven P. with a time of 50.781 seconds.
