SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Held under CASC-OR General Competition Rules, CASC-OR Race Ontario Regulations, CASC-OR Permit # 2022-BEMC-02

1. Races will be held for the following CASC-OR and VARAC classes: Pirelli Tire GT Sprints, Formula Libre, Toyo Formula 1600, Formula 4, Formula 1200, VARAC Formula Classic, VARAC Vintage Historic, VARAC Classic and Radical Canada Cup.

First Practice Session on Saturday, Sept.17, 2022 will begin at 08:30 am sharp.

CREWMEMBERS: Each full entry will be limited to 6 members. Co-Drivers and additional entries are not entitled to additional crewmembers. 2nd drivers will take the place of a crewmember. Co-Drivers in the 2 Hour Enduro will not be considered crewmembers.

- 2. Insurance for this event is provided through the CASC-OR Stoneridge Master Policy.
- 3. Paddock:

Teams setting up in the paddock need to be efficient in their use of space and respect the need to share space with other competitors. Where possible, please setup your paddock space in a perpendicular manner.

Vehicle parking (non-competition) in the paddock needs to be done with respect for the traffic lanes used by race vehicles to get to and from the track – specifically, parking near the gas pump is discouraged and cars may be towed from that location if they are blocking access. Due to the number of entries expected, please park all non-essential vehicles on the grass areas adjacent to the lower paddocks.

- 4. BEMC reserves the right to change the official schedule with respect to order, the length and or groupings of any session.
- 5. Any competitor needing to see a Clerk may ask any BEMC official with a radio to contact the Clerk for directions and to arrange a meeting.
- 6. Race Medical is located in the 'Garages'. Gasoline Alley must have one clear lane for emergency vehicle use. Parking of non-emergency vehicles is not allowed.
- 7. Scrutineering will be at the CASC trailer, located in the paddock behind the "Garages".
- 8. All persons who wish to enter a restricted area must sign the insurance waiver and wear the appropriate wristband as issued by BEMC. Waivers for minors (under the age of 18) are available through the CASC-OR web site or at registration. For purposes of this event restricted areas are:
 - i. Pit lane
 - ii. Pit boxes
 - iii. Mock Grid
 - iv. Track side as defined by existing spectator fences
 - v. BEMC signage

Enforcement will be by BEMC officials and Marshals working in these areas.

- 9. Mock Grid will be located on the apron behind the easterly end of pit lane and on the portion of the pit lane adjacent. The 60 kph pit speed limit will extend the full length of both the pit and mock grid areas.
- 10. All races shall be rolling starts using the Canadian flag. The normal green flag will be used for restarts if required.
- 11. Be aware that BEMC may <u>dispatch emergency and service vehicles</u> during all cool down laps and/or onto the "hot" track at any time and from any location <u>without a race stoppage or without a full course caution</u>. These vehicles may be stationed at 2, 2A, 4, 5, 5B, 6, 8, 9, 10 or pit out.
- 12. During full course yellow conditions the pit exit shall be closed each lap when the Safety Car reaches the Starter's Bridge. The pit exit shall remain closed until the main pack has passed the pit exit as per the 2022 CASC-OR Race Regulations, Appendix H: 4.1.5.
- 13. Notices and Results will be posted in the Classroom beside Race Medical.

- 14. The Penalty Box will be located under the bridge in Pit Lane.
- 15. Paddock announcements may be heard on radio FM station 90.7. Text messaging may also be used.

SPECIFIC TO THE ENDURO:

- 16. As approved by the CASC-OR Race Director, Radicals are eligible to enter the Enduro as long as they meet the following:
 - 1. Has a forward facing 'bright' light attached to the roll bar
 - 2. Has been approved by the Chief Event Scrutineer
- 17. Repaired vehicles returning to the race from the paddock will do so using Gasoline Alley.
- 18. The pits available for use by competitors to be used for the Enduro will be restricted to the northern portion commonly known as the "original pits".
- 19. Enduro entries will comply with the 2022 CASC-OR Race Regulations, Appendix O Section F with the following exceptions:

The Penalties associated with – 3.4 Breakouts and 4.0 Reclassification will not be in effect for the Enduro. Cars breaking out will automatically move to the next higher class.

- 20. The Enduro is not part of the 2022 Pirelli Tire program.
- 21. The chequered flag ending the Endruo will be displayed to the leader at the conclusion of the time period OR at curfew 18.45 hrs (6:45pm) whichever is the earlier.
