# 2023 Decal Requirements

- Road Racing Rules / Bulletins | CASC Ontario Region
- BULLETIN: 2023-RR-01
- Cars will be inspected on the mock grid before races for compliance with the decal requirements
- One track session if you are non-compliant
- Ineligible for championship points if you remain non-compliant after the warning

- The overall points winner from these three events will be named the 2023 Motomaster Track Master Champion



# Scoring Revisions

2023 CASC-OR Race Regulations, Appendix P, Section 7

 Based on discussions at the 2022 Race Workshop held last November, the scoring system has been modified so that there is no longer any bias for the number of entries in a class

 This applies to Pirelli Super Touring, Pirelli Grand Touring, Formula Libre and Formula Prototype Challenge scoring

## 2023 Podium Presentations

- We will be utilizing each of the track's podiums for 2023
- Podium presentations will follow the feature race for each run group
- Park in the designated areas and make your way to the podiums as quickly as possible
- New for 2023, Penni Barker has been appointed the CASC-OR Master of Ceremonies and will run the podium presentations at regional events

#### Logbooks

- If you need a new or replacement logbook there is an online form to be filled in at Log Book Application Form.
- Once that is received, the logbook will be created and ready for you at the next event you attend. If you need it before then, please let us know at <a href="RaceTech@CASC.on.ca">RaceTech@CASC.on.ca</a> and we will arrange a pickup or delivery.

#### **Annual Inspection Records**

- We have been recording and tracking annual inspections in a Scrutineering database. Now we are going to use that database to determine who needs an inspection at each event.
- However, you need to update your logbook information in MS Reg so that we can connect the annual inspection to your car. This means enter the logbook and VIN if you have one.
- Anyone who is registered but doesn't have a logbook recorded will be contacted to record it prior to the event or during the event.

#### **Annual Technical Stickers**

- When you pass your annual inspection, the inspector will put your Annual Inspection Sticker on your car. Once this is placed on your car, you will not need another technical inspection sticker for the rest of the year.
- Note that these are numbered so it is important that the right sticker is placed on the right car.
