Road Racing Report

Here we are, the end of the 2025 season.

Second year as Race director and I haven't lost my ambitious thoughts ...lol.

I'd like to thank John Bordin for jumping into Mike & Marry's shoes at the 11th hour to help navigate the CASC scrutineering side and everything he does for BARC. Without these two our season wouldn't have been as successful. And to the countless other volunteers. Without these people, we'd halt so a million thank you's.

By the numbers, we had a successful year. Through our amazing sponsors, we raised some funds to help with expenses to make the experience more exciting for our competitors. We saw a substantial increase in registrations at BEMC STR, SMP & CMP, which was great to see, but unfortunately BARC, BEMC LSTR & Celebration saw a decline but overall, we are up. Total registrations of 675 in 2024 to 710 in 2025.

Our Multi event packages sold well also. We had forty-one competitors who took advantage of this program, and we will continue this for 2026. The total number of licenses from 2024 to 2025 was the same.

Another substantial moment saw us take our Miata Canada Cup to the Toronto Indy. We were a crowd favorite, and we received incredible exposure from this. I genuinely believe that exposing the public to what we do is slowly helping bring in new and curious faces with events like Motorama & Indy.

We continue to get great feedback from competitors, volunteers & general attendees regarding announcements by Pat G, Alex G and Niki. We will continue this program into 2026. I've received great reviews of our REV TV show also. Sponsors are pleased and the competitors I speak with love it. Although the production cost isn't inexpensive, I believe we should continue this as we continue to build up the CASC branding.

We did have a few bumps with timing this year, learning the new system and at times issues that were out of our control, made for some stressful moments but we are committed to bringing in special teams to help with training in all departments.

2026 is looking exciting as I've been contacted by a few other series that would like to run with us.

We are currently working and a schedule that can help this along. We have accepted a deal to run our MCC at the NASCAR event at CMP in July and it will be a points race. With CMP going ahead with its plans to pave their track, 2026 will make for a great season.

Ice Racing Report

I am incredibly pleased to report that 2025 was an excellent year for Ice Racing. We were able to complete 6 events and entries were up significantly over 2023. This was the third year the Ice Racing Director position was vacant, so once again, I stepped in.

We were truly fortunate that our new Promotions Manager, Elaine Willis, was able to secure 4 sponsors whom we'd like to recognize and thank: Car Quest Minden, Syntheia.ai, RSR, and Ken Shaw Toyota. Without their generous support, ice racing might no longer be financially viable.

In 2025 we created a new "introductory" run group called Street Cup. This class runs with minimally converted/prepared cars on studded tires with no contact permitted. Conceptually, a competitor could drive their car to the track, swap their tires, tape up their lights, and add a number, then go racing. 2025 allowed us to work out the bugs – in 2026 we are hoping this class grows to introduce new competitors to the sport. As in all the CASC-OR Divisions, Ice Racing is experiencing a manpower shortage. It takes a very dedicated team of officials and volunteers to make the series happen. If you are a racer, consider whether you can bring someone to the track to help work at the events. If you can't run the full series yourself, you can help at the events you don't enter...

For 2026, we have set a 6-event schedule. The Pre-series Tech Day will be January 17, and then we will be racing every weekend (that the weather allows us) from January 24 to March 1.
