All other non-members will select from available numbers in MS Reg but the organizers reserve the right to make number changes the morning of the event.

Ruleset

We use the CASC/SoloSport Canada Ruleset for both TLMC and the CASC Regional Series.

Entry fees

Event #1 (Day)

\$30 per entry per event for TLMC members and CASC regionally registered competitors.

\$40 per entry per event for non-members.

Event #2 (Evening)

\$40 per entry per event for TLMC members and CASC regionally registered competitors.

\$50 per entry per event for non-members.

Since the second event will take place after the sun sets, any cars without working headlights will be scheduled to run early in their run group or possibly moved to an earlier group.

COVID Information

Federal, Provincial and Local Government guidelines will be followed.

No spectators are allowed.

Co-drives are permitted at the car owner's discretion.

Absolutely no passengers or ride-alongs unless they reside in the same household or are immediate family members.

Please socially distance, even when outdoors.

If unable to social distance, please wear a mask, even when outdoors.

If you are feeling unwell or are experiencing symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath please stay home.

If you have been in contact with someone who has been experiencing these symptoms in the last two weeks, please stay home.

Refunds will be available for any COVID related reasons for not attending.

Make sure your MotorsportReg contact phone number is up to date for contact tracing.

General Event Information

Only authorized people are to come within 3 metres of the timing tent.

Food will be available for purchase throughout the day courtesy of a food truck.

The paddock area is a mixture of grass and gravel so plan accordingly.

There will be bugs as the day wears on so plan accordingly.

The grid area is small and only a certain number of cars will be allowed to grid at a given time.

Driving speeds in the paddock, grid and entering and exiting the course are to be kept at a minimum. Less than 20 km/h.

More than one driver may be registered per car. Drivers are not allowed to compete in more than one car.

If sharing a car, each driver must register and pay separately.

All cars need to have numbers clearly displayed on both sides of the car. TLMC will no longer provide number plates.

Two driver cars should only have one number visible while on course.

Loaner helmets are no longer available.

All helmets MUST meet the criteria outlined by the CASC SoloSport Canada Ruleset outlined below. Helmets will be checked.

Acceptable helmets:

- FIA 8860-2010
- FIA 8859-2015
- Snell 2020 SA, or M 2020 D or M 2020 R

- Snell 2015 SA, or 2015 M
- Snell 2010 SA, 2010 SAH, or 2010 M (expiry 31.12.2023)
- SFI Foundation 31.1/2015
- SFI Foundation 31.1/2010
- ECE R22.05 ECE 22.05 (expiry: ten years after date of manufacture as noted on unaltered, helmet label)

Helmets homologated to Snell M, ECE 22.05, and ECE R22.05 standard are not acceptable for use in vehicles equipped with roll cages

Marshalling

We will marshal using three run groups, one will run, another will marshal, and the other will be on break...then we'll rotate.

Marshal positions will be assigned for the entire event upon check in.

Marshals will check in every time their run group reports for marshalling.

All competitors **MUST** marshal during the event.

Do not take pictures or use your cell phone while marshalling.

Marshals are to be socially distanced and only one marshal in each area will operate the radio and red flag.

Marshals for the second event will be provided with high visibility vests to wear after the sun sets.

The Event and/or Series Organizers have the right to refuse entry or disqualify a competitor from competition for any reason at any time without refunds. Decisions of the organizers are final.
